Scholarship Application Trade/Vocational School

OBJECTIVE

The objective of the Roosevelt County Electric Education Foundation Scholarship Fund is to assist those individuals who desire to further their education and who desire to acquire the knowledge and skills to be better prepared to participate in the future employment marketplace. One-year scholarships, in an amount to be determined on an annual basis by the Education Foundation, will be considered provided the following eligibility requirements have been met:

ELIGIBILITY

All criteria listed below must be met:

1. Available to dependents of members receiving service from Roosevelt County Electric Cooperative, Inc. or a legal dependent of a full-time employee of a member receiving service from the cooperative, and said employee must be living in a residence connected in the member's name.
2. Scholarships to be granted to attend an accredited trade, vocational, or technical school.
3. Applicant must be of good character as evidenced by a minimum of two (2) letters of recommendation of which at least one (1) must be from a teacher, professor, or counselor from the institution they are currently attending or a business professional in the proposed trade.
4. To be considered by the registrar to be a full-time student in good standing or be attending the program for the first time.

SELECTION PROCESS

Selections will be determined by the Roosevelt County Electric Education Foundation selection committee.

THESE ARE ONE (1) YEAR SCHOLARSHIPS. PERSONS WHO WISH TO RECEIVE A FUTURE SCHOLARSHIP MUST RE-APPLY EACH YEAR. SCHOLARSHIPS WILL BE AWARDED ON THE CRITERIA SET FORTH ABOVE.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Submit the scholarship application with the required information/documentation *by 5 P.M., Friday, January 30, 2026.*

4. One page or less typed or handwritten essay on how this scholarship will aid applicants in their educational goals.
